**ENTRIES: \$20.00 per class & \$20.00 Warm Up Classes (Before 6 PM Wed. 4/14/21)- NO EXCEPTIONS!!**

There will be a post entry fee of \$25 per horse/rider entry if entered after April 14 6:00 PM.

**HUNTER CLASSICS:** to enter the classis the same pony/rider combination must have competed in the corresponding division at the show. The second hunter class of the division will be scored as the 1<sup>st</sup> round of the ClassicAll horses/ponies can return for the Derbies' 2<sup>nd</sup> round. **Hunter Classic Fee is \$35.**

**ENTRY FORMS will not be accepted unless signed by the owner/authorized agent, rider and trainer. No numbers will be issued without an open check. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched or classes being scratched or else the class fee may be charged.**

**COGGINS:** Current coggins must be presented to the horse show office for all horses on the grounds. Please note barn affiliation on entry form and check.

**SCHOOLING:** No schooling on Saturday. See Show schedule for schooling times for each ring

**FEEES:** \$20.00 office/benefit/scholarship fee will be charged for every horse & rider combination. \$5 EMT fee per entry, per day. A fee of \$15 may be charged for open checks not closed out by the end of the show. **RETURNED CHECKS:** A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks. **DOGS:** There will be **NO DOGS:** NO Dogs are

allowed on Propering Farm property

**ATTIRE:** SEI APPROVED HELMETS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHLE MOUNTED. Riders must be properly attired – no chaps. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible.

**RIBBONS, TROPHIES, and CHAMPIONSHIP:** All classes receive a prize and 6 ribbons. All Divisions will be awarded Champion and Reserve ribbons using the standard tally system: 10, 7, 5, 3, 2, 1. In the event of a tie, management will break the tie by over fences points. Champion rosette and trophy will be awarded and Reserve rosettes. (Champion add 10 points and Reserve adds 6 points)

**CHANGES:** Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be cancelled.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** Submission of entry to these shows constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Prospering Farm and NTHJC officials against any claim, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fee for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or it's use of the premises or from any breach on the part of Exhibitors of an conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests, or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and Prospering Farm and NTHJC Management is not responsible for accidents, fire, or theft.

**MEMBERSHIP:** A non-member fee of \$20 will apply to horse/rider combinations that are not members of NTHJC. Memberships may be done online at [www.nthjc.com](http://www.nthjc.com) or at horse show office with a separate payment

**STABLING:** Limited stabling available on a first come, first serve basis. \$75, includes shavings. All stalls must be prepaid by Venmo @Susan-Horn-16. Prospering Farm is not responsible if you send your money by Venmo and you send to the wrong person.

**Limit Divisions:** are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences.

**After winning 5 blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in the division for the remainder of the show season. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at the same show. Riders will receive YEAR END AWARDS for the Limit Divisions!**

**CROSS ENTRIES:** Horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference

**SPLIT CLASSES:** All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split

**NTHJC MEDAL CLASSES -** The Medal Class will be open to all riders for the entire show season. The Top 8 point earners for the year will be invited to compete in the Medal Finals at the Year End Show.

Prospering Farm will be offering the NTHJC High Point Thoroughbred Hunter & Jumper Awards.
